



## Bringing Peace to Relationships (DV/AM MRT)

Confidentiality is an important part of the program’s success. Everything you hear or say in any group session MUST stay within the group. Breaking the commitment of confidentiality is grounds for automatic discharge from the MRT program. **Exception: The facilitator or other staff that are involved in the program will report drug use, criminal or planned criminal activity, and violations of supervision conditions to the Probation officer and or Judge/Commissioner.**

Active Participation in program activities and completion of reading and homework assignments is required. Some of the important program requirements are as follows:

1. Bring all program materials to each group meeting. If you fail to bring your book to class, you will be unable to present a treatment module.
2. Non-alcoholic beverages with a lid/top are permitted.
3. Be on time for groups! If you are late, you will not be allowed to participate that week and it will count as an absence.
4. Dress appropriately for treatment. No hats or alcohol/drug related clothing items are allowed.
5. Abstain from any offensive language, disruptive or any other inappropriate behavior.
6. Participants may not appear under the influence of any intoxicants. You will be removed from group and it will count as an un-excused absence and returned to court for non-compliance. Appearing more than one time under the influence and you will be removed from the program.
7. There will be no cell phones, headphones, or personal electronics allowed. You must be able to focus and pay attention in the group.
8. Show respect for staff, volunteers, and other program participants.
9. Participants must pay the \$125.00 course fee prior to beginning the program. If you lose your MRT workbook, notify the MRT facilitator immediately and a new workbook will be provided to you once payment in the amount of \$25.00 is received. These fees are non-refundable.
10. You will have three opportunities to complete each MRT module. Failure to complete in 3 attempts will result in a possible return to court for non-compliance.
11. You are permitted only 3 un-excused absences. After 3 absences you will be returned to court in non-compliance. After 5 un-excused absences you will be removed from the program.
12. Comply with the conditions of supervision and all program rules and regulations. Failure to comply with any of the above rules could result in being sent home early from the group which will count as an absence.
